
In the Country

AT HOME WITH THE GLYNNS, by Eric Kraft (Crown, 181 pages). Holden Caulfield meets magic realism in this strangely enchanting little book, one in a series (The Personal History, Adventures, Experiences & Observations of Peter Leroy) about a 12-yearold boy in a 1950s Long Island town. While ostensibly the tale of a love affair young Peter has with the Glynns' slightly older twin daughters, the book is an exploration of time, memory, truth and trust, and Kraft is a master of dialogue and description.
